### Countdown to Lent - Ash Wednesday - February 17<sup>th</sup>

A friendly reminder! In the Roman Rite (us) Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of fasting and of abstinence from meat. We are also encouraged to do penance on these days. Forms of penance are fasting, almsgiving, prayer and works of mercy. Fasting obtains its full meaning when we deprive ourselves of food in order to be more open for prayer and for sharing with people who are starving. Lent is a call to prepare to renew our Baptism at Easter by prayer and penance. So, I would like to invite you personally to join with your sisters and brothers in St. Francis for our weekly celebration of the Eucharist (Mass). You are also invited to celebrate the sacrament of reconciliation (confession) as part of your Lenten plans.
