



FundScrip is an innovative program that earns cash rebates for St. Francis of Assisi Parish. Every month you spend hundreds of dollars for things like groceries, gas, clothing, pharmacy, restaurants, electronics, home and garden, department stores, entertainment and more.



You can purchase cards by completing an order form available at the parish or on the parish website or purchase cards after weekend Masses from the supply on hand. Cards are bought at face value from FundScrip participating retailers. A complete list of the cards available can be found on the Paper Order Form. There is no administration fee and no expiry date. A percentage of every card purchased contributes to St. Francis' fundraising efforts. Funds raised will benefit projects and programs at St. Francis of Assisi Parish.

You make your usual visit to the store. Instead of paying with cash or a debit card, you use a card that you purchased through the FundScrip program. It costs you nothing extra but you earned money for St. Francis of Assisi Parish.

Support St. Francis of Assisi Parish By Purchasing Your Cards

The cards come preloaded and are available in various denominations. As you use the cards, the value of the purchase is automatically deducted from the value stored on the card. If you don't use the entire amount, the balance remains on the card and can be used for future purchases. Your receipt will show you the value remaining on the card. You can also ask the cashier to put a sticker on your card showing the remaining balance. Or you can phone the number on the back of each card to find out the current balance.

Within the first six months of the program, four hundred and sixty (460) cards were sold to over thirty (30) individuals or groups for a value of almost sixteen thousand dollars (\$16,000) with net proceeds of almost four hundred dollars (\$400) for our parish. Now, that may not sound like a lot of money realized but, one, there was very little effort put forth to raise that money, two, only a small amount of our parishioners participated, third, they spent no additional money to raise those funds, and fourth, they could still use their reward program cards for points.
